■ **GOT To Dance judges have warned they will be more ruthless than ever ditching wannabes this series.**

Kimberly Wyatt, 32, hit out at rival reality shows, hinting they are more bothered about making telly than finding talent.

Speaking to the Daily Star Sunday, she said: "It's real what we do on the show. It's not about creating good moments for TV. It's about talent."

Kimberly, right, is in her fifth year on the panel of the Sky1 series.

She said the audition heats left her an emotional wreck.

"It does become quite personal sending acts home," she said.

■ "The thing is, you aren't turning down bad talent. Everybody that comes to us is amazing at what they do. But you've got to pick between what's good and the best.

"It's the same as the process you'd find in the industry. All of us judges have been through that."

Judge Adam Garcia, 41, said wannabes had a tough time impressing the panel this series.

He said: "People know the level that's expected for the show now. We were tougher than we've ever been."

The first audition aired last night, with another instalment tonight at 10pm on Sky1.
